

Dress on the Course

All players are to be neatly dressed on the golf course, which includes the practice putting green and practice fairway. Members of the Board of Directors, Golf Management Committee, Women Golfers' Executive Committee, Match Sub-Committee, Golf Professional and his staff and Club staff reserve the right to refuse admission to any person not suitably attired.

Male Golfers

The following rules pertain to male golfers only:

Permitted

Shirts with a collar and sleeves, polo style (turtle neck or skivvie style is acceptable).

Neat dress style trousers or shorts of single basic colour.
Cargo style pants.
Dress jeans (not torn or tattered).

Golf shoes or appropriate sports shoes without exaggerated sole patterns.

Short/ankle socks predominantly white. Long socks must be pulled up.

Not Permitted

T-shirts, tank tops, singlet tops, shirts (or jumpers) with slogans or prominent advertising material.

Athletic/sports style pants with stripes etc. Camouflage colours, track suit pants/drawstring style or elastic waist shorts or pants.

Any other style of footwear.

Football socks.

Female Golfers

The following rules pertain to female golfers only:

Permitted

Shirts or blouses displaying designer logos. Polo shirts and round neck tee shirts with sleeves.

Skirts, shorts and culottes (no more than 10cm above the knee). Capri pants.
Slacks and Plus Fours.
Dress jeans (not torn or tattered).

Golf shoes or appropriate sports shoes without exaggerated sole patterns.

Not permitted

Shirts displaying advertising motifs or slogans, tracksuit and singlet tops.

Brief shorts.
Track suit pants, lycra tights, faded or tattered jeans.

Any other style of footwear.
